Stephanie Turner mentioned a new art resource for our art sales in the Spring. Sarah Skerker and the art teacher at KP have already reviewed and like both the new & old programs. Sam Elson took information back with him regarding the new company and is going to talk to the KG art teacher and report back to us.

Motion was made, seconded and carried not to fund the request from the FLEX program this year. We agreed to put it on the agenda to review when creating next year's budget.

Motion was made, seconded and carried to add a variety of reward programs (from area retailers) to our web site and also to send out a flyer for same...asking parents to sign up KP/KG on their accounts.

Motion was made, seconded and carried to hold a spirit night at Kings Park McDonald's some time in January.

Stephanie Turner reviewed the items discussed at a recent treasurer's workshop she attended. Last year's audit was adopted. Additionally, we agreed to pursue the creation of a budget in the Spring for the 2009/10 school year.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:00 p.m. and immediately followed by Sharon K. Weiss, M.Ed. a behavioral consultant. This portion of the meeting was well attended.
