- I. Call Meeting to Order Jen Argenta
 - A. The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m.
- II. Approval of Minutes from February 3, 2026 ALL

 - A. Bethany Portock motioned for the minutes to be approved; Sarah Tremper seconded.
 - B. The minutes were approved as written.
- III. Principals' Reports Dotty Lin, Christine Ritter
 - A. Kings Park
 - Military connected students were recognized this week as military service is a whole family commitment. Activities included Purple Up Spirit Week and military connected morning meetings.
 - STEAM activities continue with a STEAM night; STEAM learning activities in Strategies Lab, and a STEAM Open House.
 - Students have been enjoying field trips including 3rd graders visiting Huntley Meadows, 2nd graders visiting the American History Museum, and Preschoolers also visiting Huntley Meadows.
 - Kings Park is celebrating student attendance with a 6% chronic absenteeism rate.
 - Susan Fliess, a local Author and Illustrator with a STEAM focus, will be visiting Kings Park. Thank you to the PTA for the funds to pay for this visit.
 - Grade level teams will use school support lines for grade level parties and school supplies, among other things.
 - Family information, submitted through a Google form, for class placements is due May 5th.
 - 3rd graders have been practicing in the cafeteria for their SOL. Review of grade level standards is occurring to prepare students for their assessments. There has been a focus on student achievement and perseverance.
 - The Reading SOL will take place on May 6th, and the Math SOL will take place on May 14th.
 - There is no school on Tuesday, April 21st due to the elections, and April 22nd is a full day of school.
